

Robert (Rob) Elliott is a Senior Fish Biologist who has worked with Great Lakes fish community assessment, research and rehabilitation since 1993. He currently coordinates the Service's lake sturgeon assessment and rehabilitation on Lake Michigan and in cooperation with other partners, has focused on lake sturgeon status assessments, ecology, genetic structuring, historic distribution, early life history, habitat evaluation and protection, development of streamside rearing, and design, implementation and evaluation of fish passage at large dams. He has co-authored or authored numerous peer-reviewed publications focusing on lake sturgeon and also lake trout and salmon fisheries and biology. Rob is an active participant in the Lake Michigan Technical Committee and many of its subcommittees, has served as chair of the Lake Michigan Lake Sturgeon work group for many years, and also coordinates and assists numerous Tribes with their fisheries needs.
