

must be:


- ▣ Legal
- ▣ Feasible
- ▣ Addresses injured resources
- ▣ Not intended for remedial clean-up
- ▣ Not proposed by responsible party

Project Scoring (continued)

Proposed
projects
should be:

- ▣ Near area of injury
- ▣ Benefitting valuable resources
- ▣ Expedient
- ▣ Non-environmentally damaging
- ▣ Cost-effective
- ▣ Monitored
- ▣ Likely to succeed




Riparian Habitat Restoration

- Variety of restoration projects to benefit migratory birds can be considered, riparian areas and areas impacted by mining are a priority
- Projects could include: Native vegetation planting, 'Daylighting' of enclosed streams, replacing concrete channels with natural substrate, cattle exclusion fencing
- Conservation easement or other administrative protection on land acquired and restored
- Funds for habitat maintenance will be provided



Upland Compensatory RFP




Prairie Habitat Restoration

- Ability to acquire, hold easement upon, and manage prairie.
- Ability to acquire degraded prairie, fescue pasture, etc. and restore prairie function
- Conservation easement or other administrative protection required on land acquired and restored
- Particular parcels not expected at time of application.
- Funds for future maintenance will be provided.



Jasper Primary Acquisition RFP



Primary Jasper Acquisition RFP

- Priorities are terrestrial, riparian, and wetland habitats (not groundwater or rivers) that have been cleaned-up as part of the remedial process
- Property acquisition or easement acquisition are intended activities
- Subsequent RFP for restoration activities will follow, for lands acquired under this RFP. Funds for habitat maintenance will be provided.
- Land must be managed for wildlife habitat, and must have conservation easement or other administrative protection
