

Big day on Bucks' Lake, Sunday, February 7th.....five matures on the dead fish at a time, five more in the trees, just one immature out of eleven eagles in area.....BIGGEE.....A most reliable observer asked, "Is it possible that I saw an eagle with white head and vegetation gathered in its talons on February 4th.??

The last time we observed this behavior, the vegetation being transported was corn "stalks" as the eagle built its Kelm Lake nest in 2008. Is this early behavior????? The year the Bucks' Lake nest was built, "stick debris" was being carried to the nest by BOTH birds on Christmas Day. [REDACTED] always kidded that the eagles were giving one another presents for Christmas..... [REDACTED]
