Reporting Requirements

North American Wetlands Conservation Act (103 Stat. 1968; 16 U.S.C. 4401-4412)

Sec. 10. REPORT TO CONGRESS.

The Secretary shall report to the appropriate Committees on the implementation of this Act. The report shall include—

(1) a biennial assessment of—

(A) the estimated number of acres of wetlands and habitat for waterfowl and other migratory birds that were restored, protected, or enhanced during such two-year period by Federal, State, and local agencies and other entities in the United States, Canada, and Mexico;

(B) trends in the populations size and distribution of North American migratory birds;

(C) the status of efforts to establish agreements with nations in the western hemisphere pursuant to section 16; and

(D) wetlands conservation projects funded under this Act, listed and identified by type, conservation mechanism (such as acquisition, easement, or lease), location, and duration.

(2) an annual assessment of the status of wetlands conservation projects, including an accounting of expenditures by Federal, State, and other United States entities, and expenditures by Canadian and Mexican sources to carry out these projects.

Sec. 16. OTHER AGREEMENTS.

The Secretary shall undertake with the appropriate officials of nations in the western hemisphere to establish agreements, modeled after the [North American Waterfowl Management] Plan or the [Tripartite] Agreement, for the protection of migratory birds identified in section 13(a)(5) of the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act of 1980 (16 U.S.C. 2912(a)). When any such agreements are reached, the Secretary shall make recommendations to the appropriate Committees on legislation necessary to implement the agreements.

Executive Summary

This Congressionally-mandated report presents the projects funded through the North American Wetlands Conservation Act (NAWCA) in fiscal years 2016 and 2017. In this time period, partners leveraged \$93,901,870 in NAWCA grants to protect, restore and enhance wetland habitat in 35 U.S. states, 12 Canadian provinces and 32 Mexican states. Partners will provide at least \$273,706,662 in match to affect 630,651 acres.

By law, the NAWCA grant program provides matching grants to partnerships who want to conserve lands and waters that are vital to waterfowl and other wetland-associated migratory birds. Since 1991, NAWCA has funded more than 2,700 projects to benefit more than 30 million acres of habitat in North America. Partners have contributed well over \$3 billion to match \$1.5 billion awarded in NAWCA grants, exceeding the \$1-to-\$1 match requirement.

Partners are the foundation of this continental conservation effort. Recognizing local wetland conservation needs, agencies, landowners, hunting groups, conservation organizations, businesses, and other interests come together to develop solutions and support these projects with matching funds. They stretch conservation dollars and implement projects that benefit wildlife and communities. Since 1991, more than 5,700 partners have leveraged NAWCA funds to achieve our shared conservation goals.

NAWCA-supported projects may involve just a few partners, or a dozen or more organizations and individuals. They may be working together for the first time, or continuing collaborations that span decades. While the projects are developed and implemented locally, they help meet regional and national migratory bird management objectives, maximizing their effectiveness and contributing to intercontinental conservation goals.

While conserving wildlife habitat is NAWCA's primary goal, the lands and waters affected by grant projects provide hunting, fishing, photography, and wildlife viewing opportunities. Over 100 million Americans participated in those activities in 2016, spending over \$150 billion - a significant boost to local and regional economies. These same habitats also provide vital services to communities, supporting cleaner water, flood control that reduces the severity of storms, and ground water recharge that allows more farmers and ranchers to work the land. In so many places, in so many ways, NAWCA projects continue to deliver value to the American people.

- An overview of NAWCA priority species population levels based on surveys conducted by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's Migratory Bird Program and our partners.

- Members of the North American Wetlands Conservation Council and the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission, which recommend and approve grant projects, respectively.



Migratory Bird Trends

Federal, provincial, and state agencies conduct surveys each spring to estimate the size of breeding waterfowl populations and to evaluate habitat conditions. These surveys, collectively known as the Waterfowl Breeding Population and Habitat Survey (WBPHS), are conducted using airplanes and helicopters, and cover over 2 million square miles that encompass principal waterfowl breeding areas of North America.

In 2017, many overabundant temperate-nesting goose populations remained above management objective levels, despite efforts to reduce their abundance. Of the 27 goose and swan populations that the US Fish and Wildlife Service reported on in 2017, eight showed a significant positive trend during the previous 10 years, and none showed a negative trend.

The traditional survey area of the WBPHS includes the prairie and parkland habitats in Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, North and South Dakota, Montana and the Northwest Territories, while the eastern survey area includes portions of Ontario, Quebec, Labrador, Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick, New York, and Maine. A time series for assessing changes in American black duck population status is provided by the breeding waterfowl surveys conducted by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and the Canadian Wildlife Service in the eastern survey area.

In addition, population trends of some additional wetland-associated bird species can be calculated based on information derived from the North American Breeding Bird Survey (BBS). This survey takes place annually in June in the United States (excluding Hawaii) and Canada, and with limited coverage in Mexico. The BBS is conducted by trained volunteers who count all birds seen and heard at 50 stops evenly spaced on each of more than 5,000 ground-based routes, each around 25 miles long.

The BBS provides population trend information for 86 species of game and nongame wetland-breeding birds (those recorded on more than 14 BBS routes). From 2005-2015, 2% of these species exhibited a significant negative trend, while 27% exhibited a significant positive trend.

NAWCA funds may be used for conservation and restoration of grassland habitats, provided they are adjacent to wetland habitat. The BBS provides population trend information on 28 grassland-breeding birds (those recorded on more than 14 BBS routes). From 2005-2015, 7% of these species exhibited a significant positive trend, and 25% exhibited a negative trend. Note that the precision of BBS estimates and the ability to detect trends depends in part on the number of routes where birds were observed, so inference about species that are infrequently observed on BBS routes is limited.

The United States Fish and Wildlife Service continues working with national and international partners to manage and conserve migratory bird populations and their breeding and wintering habitats through the North American Waterfowl Management Plan and other programs, such as the North American Bird Conservation Initiative and Partners in Flight.

International Agreements

In 2016, representatives from the U.S., Canada and Mexico created a framework for a vision that broadens already successful conservation efforts to encompass the entire Western Hemisphere, recognizing that many birds traverse not just national borders but continental ones, as well. The vision calls for a strong collaborative effort across the public and private sectors - informed by sound science - to confront the new challenges facing bird and habitat conservation.
