- assist with habitat management
- assist other wildlife surveys
- data entry, organization, analysis

- knowledge of wildlife biology, zoology, natural resources biology or related field
- enthusiasm for field work
- able to work independently and in small groups
- physically fit
- personal vehicle required for local non-work travel
