


Trustee Council Resolution #10
March 5, 2013

The Kansas Trustee Council (Trustees) authorizes the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism (KDWPT) to initiate filling a Natural Resource Damages and Restoration (NRD) position. The position will be a habitat restoration technician.

The habitat restoration technician position is an unclassified, temporary, full-time position. The position will facilitate implementation of NRD restoration activities and management of existing and future NRD restoration property acquisitions and existing KDWPT wildlife areas in Cherokee and surrounding counties as prescribed in the 2013 *NRDA Habitat Technician Position Proposal* submitted by KDWPT. The position term will be for one year and subject to annual renewal pending satisfactory performance review by KDWPT and the Trustees. The beginning annual salary for the habitat restoration technician is \$42,224.

The trustees are seeking a total of \$42,224 to cover the salary of the habitat restoration technician for one year. This funding will come from the joint settlement account number 0585 Cherokee County ASARCO Restoration.
