

Trustee Council Resolution #20
March 5, 2013

The Kansas Trustee Council (Trustees) authorizes the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism (KDWPT) to initiate filling a Natural Resource Damages and Restoration (NRD) position. The position will be the NRD project planner for KDWPT.

The KDWPT project planner position is an unclassified, temporary, full-time position that will facilitate implementing all aspects of NRD restoration activities and management of restoration properties in Cherokee and surrounding counties for the Trustees. Position responsibilities include quarterly reporting (including financial expenditures and tracking) to the Trustees, maintaining the geographic information system land acquisition database, restoration activities (including completing land availability reports, appraisals, and property purchases), and oversight of all restoration projects and action on acquired properties. The beginning annual salary with fringe benefits for the NRD project planner is \$77,750. The position term will be annual and subject to annual renewal pending satisfactory performance review by KDWPT and the trustees.

The trustees are seeking a total of \$77,750 to cover the first year of the project planner position. This funding will come from the joint settlement account number 0585 Cherokee County ASARCO Restoration.
