
Trustee Council Resolution #27
August 18, 2014

The Kansas Trustee Council authorizes the transfer of funds from the federal account to the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism (KDWP) via the state account for restoration and operation and maintenance on NRDA properties. The requested total is as follows:

Native Grass Restoration – NRDA Properties	\$	50,000.00
Tree and Brush Clearing/Noxious Weed Control – NRDA Properties	\$	50,000.00
Operation and Maintenance – NRDA Properties	\$	20,000.00
Property Access Development and Maintenance – NRDA Properties	\$	15,000.00
Seasonal Salary	\$	15,000.00
Total	\$	150,000.00

The Kansas Trustee Council seeks a total of \$150,000 to fund restoration and operation and maintenance on NRDA properties purchased by the Kansas Trustee Council and owned and managed by KDWP. Restoration is generally necessary to replant portions of areas initially seeded with native grasses and forbs not showing success after a growing season and to remove woody vegetation inhibiting these areas. Operation and maintenance and property access development and maintenance are generally necessary to maintain the successful restoration efforts and provide signage and safe public accessibility. The seasonal salary is generally necessary to help accomplish the aforesaid activities.

This funding will come from the joint settlement account number 0585-Cherokee County ASARCO Restoration. The total of \$150,000 will be transferred to the state fund with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE). KDHE will transmit the funds to KDWP via electronic interfund transfer.
