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



Subject: Cherokee County Superfund Project - Trustee Council Resolution #5

The Kansas Trustee Council (Trustees) has reviewed the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks' (KDWP) request dated July 15, 2010, to purchase equipment to perform restoration activities for the Cherokee County Superfund Site. KDWP has requested the Trustees purchase a skid loader, forestry cutter, rotary cutter, brush saw, root grapple and an extended warranty on the equipment. The total cost to purchase this equipment is \$80,682.73 as included in your correspondence (attached).

The Trustees have reviewed your request and agree to use NRDA funds to cover the cost. The equipment will be used for restoration actions in Cherokee, Labette, Neosho and Crawford Counties and these actions conform to the Restoration Plan for the Cherokee County Superfund Site. The Trustees agree to provide up to \$80,682.73 for the purchase of this equipment.
