



Subject: Cherokee County Superfund Project - Trustee Council Resolution #6

The Kansas Trustee Council (Trustees) has reviewed the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks' (KDWP) request to reimburse KDWP for the actual costs to implement the Cherokee County Restoration Plan. KDWP would like to have their direct labor and travel costs reimbursed to them for their efforts to implement the restoration plan. The total cost for implementing the restoration plan is estimated to be approximately \$50,000.00 per year. This is only an estimate and the actual amounts will be documented in detailed quarterly reports that will be submitted to the Trustees for review and approval.

The Trustees have reviewed your request and agrees to use NRDA funds to cover the costs of KDWP for implementing the Cherokee County Superfund Restoration Plan. The costs to implement the restoration plan in the Cherokee County area conforms to the Restoration Plan for the Cherokee County Superfund Site. The Trustees agree to provide approximately \$50,000.00 per year for reimbursement of KDWP costs.
