

## Snake River Cutthroat

On July 7<sup>th</sup> we stocked Moccasin Lake with 8,000 cutthroat. The high alpine lake near 10,000 ft on the Wind River Reservation is a very popular summer camping and fishing spot, and is monitored by the Lander FWCO.



## Kendall Warm Springs Dace

On July 21<sup>st</sup> another round of wild dace were collected by the U.S. Forest Service for Jackson NFH/USGS and Gavins Point NFH. Our 15 fish will quarantine for at least one month before joining the rest of the wild caught population. Offspring continue to reside in their own tank and total 300+.



## Partners, Outreach and Employee Development

Our summer volunteers have been successfully, and safely, giving individual tours 3-4 days a week.

Everyone must have a mask to enter the building, per Hatchery/County requirements. Visitation has been very steady with 70-80 people per day for tours.

Sleeping Indian Pond has seen increased angler numbers this year. Estimation is 10 people per day with a max of 40 on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.

Liz was part of a team tasked with updating the FIS Distribution module. She also finished comments on a Headquarters priority propagation review of the Yellowstone cutthroat trout.

Jake continued to replace gutters destroyed during the winter and repaired the undercarriage of our Chevy stocking truck that was damaged on a trip.

Mike and Chaz continued weeding and tilling the old hatchery building land for a pollinator garden.
