
Snake River Cutthroat

All eggs have hatched, buttoned up and are on feed. Of the 211,000 eggs we ended up with approximately 85% hatched after blanks, deformities and general mortality. Fairly consistent with previous years of receiving state hatchery eggs. There are symptoms of mild stress from the transfer that are being mitigated.



Kendall Warm Springs Dace

In collaboration with the co-located USGS research station, we continue to raise a small population of endangered Kendall Warm Springs Dace. In addition to 15 wild adults, we now have 300+ offspring all from regular natural spawning. Wild dace will again be collected in a few weeks by the U.S. Forest Service.



Partners, Outreach and Employee Development

On June 11th we were honored to receive a visit from Mr. Rob Wallace who is the DOI Assistant Secretary for Fish and Wildlife and Parks. It was his first tour of a hatchery and we couldn't fit it all in one hour, but we covered a decent amount and hope to see the Wyoming native again!

Upcoming

- Two summer volunteers have finished their 14 day quarantine and will begin conducting limited tours with JHAs in place and appropriate safety measures/PPE
- Stocking 8,000 Snake River cutthroat into Moccasin Lake on the Wind River Reservation
- Annual collection of 15 wild Kendall Warm Springs Dace to add genetic diversity
