## Snake River Cutthroat

In October we completed our FY20 fish stocking responsibilities when the remaining 10,000 trout were sent to Dinwoody Lake on the Wind River Reservation.

We will continue to hold 300 larger “Spartans” before moving them to the hatchery fishing pond in a few months.

## Kendall Warm Springs Dace

Wild adults and offspring populations remain at the same levels. Expanding the F1 group has been put on hold due to density constraints.

## Employee Development

Mike has been spraying all raceways and working on a solution to empty and disinfect the outside headbox over the winter.
