## Snake River Cutthroat

Most of the 2019 cutthroat were stocked for the year. Approximately 146,000 fish (28,000 lbs) have been released into Palisades Reservoir since August to fulfill state requests. One raceway remains until we have planted 10,000 in Dinwoody Lake on the Wind River Reservation.

Current 2020 cutthroat are still exhibiting signs of low level stress and mortality. Because medicated food was not recommended the tanks are covered from light exposure and being salted weekly. Feeding method has been changed to automatic in order to provide all day consistency.

The F1 population continues to expand. Wild adults remain at 30 and offspring has exceeded 400.
