

RCW Habitat Summary Information

Prior to clearing any suitable and potentially suitable foraging habitat from each lot, a table showing the number of pine trees greater than or equal to four inches diameter-at-breast-height (DBH; 4 1/2 feet above ground level) recorded in two-inch diameter classes should be provided to this office, as well as a site map showing the distribution of pine trees greater than or equal to 8 inches DBH on the property.

Note: if you are not using a diameter tape, you will need to convert from circumference to diameter (diameter = circumference/π)

DIRECTIONS FOR MEASURING A TREE AND CONVERTING IT TO DBH: Take a tape measure and wrap it around the tree at 4 1/2 feet off of the ground. Example: If the tree is 24 inches around you take that number and divide by π . π = 3.1416. Example a tree that is 24 inches around divided by 3.1416 = 7.6 DBH
