Refuge-led learning programs are offered free of charge to preschool through college classes, including topics such as Turtles, Black Bears, Red Wolves, Tracking, Birds, Wildlife Photography, and more. Visits can be two to four hours. Arrangements for programming must be made several weeks in advance by calling Tracey Rock, 252-473-1131, Ext 227. Scavenger hunt materials are available at the National Wildlife Refuges Visitor Center on Roanoke Island and at Pea Island Visitor Center to provide a great self-lead learning experience. Groups not requesting a guided program are asked to contact prior to your visit to avoid overcrowding of the facility.
