This map is provided by the Amargosa Toad Working Group to identify known locations for Amargosa toads and areas currently considered as occupied or potential habitat for the toad. The area within the red line includes some existing developed lands and the town of Beatty. Toads often occur in developed and urban areas throughout the valley and this designation should not be interpreted to suggest the need for constraints on use and development of those locations. The area within the red line also includes connections or movement corridors among sites. However, areas outside the red line may also be important for toads. Toads may move into washes or upland areas not within the red line when conditions are suitable. Sites may be interconnected in ways we currently do not know. Buffer areas may also be important to reduce threats to the toad. All these areas should be considered during land use planning.
