MIGRATORY BIRD ACT AND REGULATIONS STILL IN FORCE.

The Department of Agriculture has received inquiries from sportsmen in various parts of the United States as to the effect of the ratification of the treaty between the United States and Great Britain in reference to migratory birds upon the Migratory Bird Act of 1913 and the Regulations issued thereunder. In response the Department has made the following public announcement: In the opinion of the Department, the Migratory Bird Act and Regulations are still in force; also these will continue in operation, and the Department regards it as its duty to enforce them, pending the enactment by Congress of new legislation for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the treaty.
