GOVERNMENT COMPILING LIST
OF RABBIT BREEDERS

A list of the rabbit breeders of the United States to be printed and distributed free to persons interested in the rabbit industry or who inquire where stock may be purchased for breeding purposes is being compiled by the Biological Survey of the United States Department of Agriculture. The names will be arranged alphabetically by States, and the kinds of rabbits that each one keeps will be designated.

The bureau has on file the names of 2,000 rabbit breeders, but this is only a small portion of all those in this country engaged in the business. It is desired to make the list as complete as possible, so that it may serve as a directory and buying guide for all who are interested in any phase of rabbit keeping. Every breeder who has not received a letter should write at once to the Bureau of Biological Survey, United States Department of Agriculture, Washington, D. C., giving his name and address and the kind and number of rabbits kept, in order that his name may be included in the Government list to be issued at an early date.
