NEW DIRECTORY LISTS GAME
OFFICIALS AND ORGANIZATIONS

For the convenience of game authorities, bird-protection organizations, and others in getting information about game and game laws, the thirtieth annual "Directory of Officials and Organizations Concerned with the Protection of Birds and Game," compiled by the Bureau of Biological Survey, has just been issued by the U. S. Department of Agriculture as Miscellaneous Publication 57-M. The organization and personnel of governmental establishments in this country, Canada, Newfoundland, and Mexico are given, together with the names and addresses of officials of State-wide game and bird protective associations and societies, and of the principal national organizations interested in bird protection, including the Migratory-Bird Treaty-Act Advisory Board. The edition available to the Department of Agriculture for free distribution is limited, but copies may be obtained from the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, D. C., at 5 cents each.
