WILD SWANS IN THE UNITED STATES  
ARE PROTECTED AT ALL SEASONS

Hunting wild swans is prohibited by Federal law throughout the United States and at all times, says Paul G. Redington, Chief of the Bureau of Biological Survey, U. S. Department of Agriculture, in a statement issued today (November 14) to counteract an erroneous report to the contrary being circulated in Atlantic Coast States. Persons apprehended killing or possessing swans are subject to prosecution in the Federal courts.
