DIRECTORY FOR WILDLIFE
 CONSERVATIONISTS ISSUED



The thirty-fourth edition of the Directory of Officials and Organizations Concerned With Wildlife Protection, containing names and addresses of interested officials and societies in all parts of the United States, Canada, Newfoundland, and Mexico has been issued by the Bureau of Biological Survey, U. S. Department of Agriculture.

The booklet, Miscellaneous Publication No. 211, is for the convenience and guidance of State and organization officials and individuals interested in wildlife conservation, and may be obtained at 5 cents a copy from the Superintendent of Documents, Washington, D. C.

Following the same general form of previous publications of its kind, the new directory includes organizations that are national or state-wide in character, and the organization and directing personnel of the Bureau, including regional directors of field activities. It also contains the names and addresses of State game and fish commissioners and other State officials responsible for wildlife conservation.
