SENTENCED TO JAIL FOR ILLEGAL FUR SHIPMENT

A jail sentence of 120 days was recently imposed in Federal court at Los Angeles by Judge William P. James against John Boros of Blythe, Calif., for shipping seven illegally taken beaver to Seattle, Wash., the Biological Survey reports. The skins were seized by the Assistant Chief Patrol Officer of Washington, who was accompanied by a United States Game Management Agent. It was found the defendant had previously served, on order of a State court, 30 days in jail for killing deer.
