

Federal Aid funds come from an excise tax on sporting arms and ammunition and a fishing rods, reels, creels, and artificial lures. Distribution of the two funds is made on formulas based upon the number of paid license holders in a State and on the State area, as prescribed by law.

Acts establishing the Federal Aid to Fish and Wildlife Restoration programs also provide \$10,000 each for fish and wildlife restoration projects on Guam, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands. The total funds these territories are intitled to for the fiscal year 1963 are included in the preliminary apportionment. Both Federal Aid Acts are administered by the Fish and Wildlife Service's Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife.

Attached is a preliminary apportionment of the funds which will become available to each State July 1, 1962.
