



human beings who might drink the water. Future emphasis however, will be on the search for toxicants that will be even more selective, controlling certain unwanted fish without harming the more desirable kinds.

To carry out this intensive research program, a staff of chemists, biologists, and other specialists has been assembled at the La Crosse station. Considerable remodeling of buildings has been completed to provide adequate research facilities.

These two research stations of the Fish and Wildlife Service are expected to make a major contribution toward improved fresh-water sport and commercial fishing, Commissioner Pautzke said.
