WATERFOWL REGULATIONS PUBLIC HEARINGS SET FOR AUGUST 2

A public hearing on proposed 1977-78 hunting regulations for waterfowl and other species of migratory birds has been scheduled for August 2.

The public is invited to attend at 9 a.m., in the auditorium of the General Services Administration Building, F Street, between 18th and 19th Streets, N.W., Washington, D.C.

Participants in the meeting will review information on population status and proposed hunting regulations for waterfowl and other species of migratory birds for which framework regulations have not been made final. Public comments on these matters will be received for consideration by the Director in developing the 1977-78 hunting season frameworks.

Persons wishing to participate in this public hearing should notify the Director (FWS/MBM), U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, U.S. Department of the Interior, Washington, D.C. 20240, or call 202/343-8827. Statements of interested persons should be presented in duplicate to the Hearing Officer before or shortly after the meeting.
