HODEL ANNOUNCES FINALISTS FOR TAKE PRIDE IN AMERICA AWARDS

Secretary of the Interior Don Hodel today announced the 1986 awards program finalists for the national Take Pride in America public lands stewardship campaign.

In making the announcement on behalf of the Take Pride in America campaign partners, Hodel said, "These finalists represent the most outstanding volunteer efforts to protect and improve our public lands and resources. Selecting the exemplary programs from among these efforts will be a difficult job."

Of the more than 520 nominations received, 127 finalists from 39 states and 106 communities were selected by a screening panel and were forwarded to the Blue Ribbon Panel of Judges. The panel is reviewing these nominations for selection of the most exemplary projects. Panel members represent the Administration, the Congress, business organizations and national civic and conservation organizations.

"The nominations being reviewed by the panel represent some of the many commendable activities which Americans across the nation are undertaking to care for our public resources," Hodel added.

Take Pride in America is a national public awareness campaign to reduce abuse and promote wise use of public lands and resources. The national awards program was established to recognize outstanding public resource stewardship projects and programs, and to provide incentive for others to get involved.

In 1986, 40 States and two U.S. Territories joined with federal agencies and numerous private sector partners in the Take Pride in America campaign and awards program. Award nominations were received from these States, many of which held their own State awards programs. Applications also were received directly from individuals and organizations involved in stewardship activities in non-participating States.

Finalists were selected in 11 awards categories including: constituent organizations; businesses and corporations; youth groups; civic and citizen groups; media; educational institutions; individuals; public and private partnerships; and local, State and federal governments.

The Blue Ribbon Panel results will be announced in several weeks. A ceremony honoring all nominees, finalists and special recognition awardees is being planned for March 1987 in Washington, D.C.
