

16. Helped inventory more than 50,000 acres of forest and survey for invasive plants in Rhode Island to guide management and intervention.
17. Enhanced 5 miles of river; 81 acres of salt marsh and 72 acres of lake habitat for fish migration in Rocky Neck State Park in East Lyme, Conn., the second largest alewife herring run in the Long Island Sound.
18. Supported Narragansett Indian efforts to identify and manage important natural resources on tribal lands, including assessing invasive species, rare plants, breeding birds and wetlands.

Gulf of Maine

1. Constructed a fishway on Blackman Stream in Bradley, Maine, to restore access for alewives, American eel and sea-run trout to upstream pond and stream habitat.
2. Assessed and prioritized fish passage barriers in the Casco Bay watershed by surveying 500 structures that cross streams and potentially block migration.
3. Removed a 100-year-old dam on the Little River in the Androscoggin River watershed, opening 45 miles of historic habitat for Atlantic salmon, American eel and sea lamprey.
4. Supported seabird nesting restoration projects on Eastern Egg Rock, Outer Green, Jenny and Stratton islands.
5. Benefited waterfowl, shorebirds, wading birds, bald eagles and sea-run fish by helping protect 267 acres of habitat in the Greater Pleasant Bay.

6. Worked with others to protect 217 acres of habitat in Merrymeeting Bay and the Lower Kennebec River for several state and federal threatened and endangered species.
7. Conserved 240 acres on the York River as part of a project protecting 934 acres of wetland and upland habitat for species including diadromous fish and sharp-tailed sparrows.
