If you are between the ages of 15 and 18, are interested in working on a National Wildlife Refuge and like to work in the out-of-doors, consider applying for a Youth Conservation Corps position. The crew will work with refuge biologists, maintenance workers, and visitor services staff on projects including trail maintenance, equipment maintenance, painting, constructing and repairing facilities as well as controlling invasive plant species. Work is done on most refuges within the Eastern Massachusetts National Wildlife Refuge Complex and neighboring Conservation partner land.
