

**INTERPRETIVE INTERN  
MONOMOY NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE**

Exciting opportunity to channel your love for the outdoors! Interpretive intern positions may be available at the Monomoy National Wildlife Refuge for the summer of 2011. The position will start between May 15<sup>th</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup> and last for 12 weeks. The Refuge is a premiere nesting location for migratory shorebirds and has people visiting from across the globe. The selected applicant's duties will include developing and guiding weekly interpretive programs for audiences of all ages; providing trailside interpretation; designing and constructing refuge fliers and brochures, and working with volunteers. In addition, the position will include data entry, answering phones and responding to information requests from the public. Requirements for the position include a valid driver's license, enthusiasm, public speaking skills, ability to work independently, and the willingness to work weekends and holidays with minimal supervision and to interact with the public in a professional manner. Past experience in natural resources and/or education is desirable. Stipend will range from \$200 - 300/week depending on experience and includes free dormitory style housing. Housing is located near the visitor contact station at 30 Wikis Way, Chatham, MA.
