The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has an exciting summer employment opportunity! If you enjoy working with teenagers while protecting wildlife habitat then this is the job for you. The selected candidate will be responsible for leading a crew of five teenagers to perform maintenance and habitat management on three national wildlife refuges (NWR) in Massachusetts: Assabet River, Great Meadows and Oxbow NWR's.

The primary duties will include trail clearing and maintenance, invasive species removal, construction of boardwalks, public outreach and supervision of Youth Conservation Crew. The employee must have a valid driver's license, lift 50 lbs, work independently with little oversight from supervisor, perform tasks in a timely manner and conduct public speaking. We will accept applications within the local commuting area; housing will not be made available and employee will be responsible for transportation to and from the work site.
