**Friends of Assabet River NWR Monthly Meeting: Wednesday, November 17<sup>th</sup> 7pm** Dave Lange of The Assabet Keeping Track (AKT) team will make a brief presentation about their research and initial survey of beaver activity on and around the Refuge. The presentation
