Natural Resource Trustees Issue Draft Restoration Plan/Environmental Assessment

The Department of Interior and the State of New Jersey invite public comment on a proposed plan to restore groundwater injured as a result of hazardous substances released from the Chemical Leaman Tank Lines Superfund Site in Logan Township, Gloucester County, New Jersey. The Draft Restoration Plan/Environmental Assessment (RP/EA) proposes acquisition of lands to be managed as open space to provide high-quality groundwater recharge.
