

Representatives of the U.S. Department of the Interior, the Federal Natural Resource Trustee for the Pompton Lakes Works Natural Resource Damage Assessment (NRDA), will be holding a public information session in the gymnasium of the Lakeside Middle School in Pompton Lakes, New Jersey, beginning at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, May 18, 2016.

The goal of NRDA is to identify the extent of injuries to natural resources resulting from hazardous substance releases at a site, and determine the amount of restoration that is needed to compensate for those injuries. Damage claims are developed for the loss to the public of natural resources, and the functions those natural resources provide. Once the claim is resolved, the Trustees undertake actions to restore injured habitats and resources. The public information session will describe the NRDA process and the status of the Pompton Lakes Works NRDA.
