### Volunteers are needed to help us build a living shoreline at Gandy's Beach in Downe Township Cumberland County, NJ



**Volunteering doesn't need to be a heavy lift:** There are opportunities for people of most ages and activity levels to assist in the installation of the living shoreline project.

#### **Volunteer Roles:**

1. Pick up, carry or pass shell bags (~20 lbs.) and/or oyster castle blocks (~30 lbs.) and arrange bags and blocks onto the constructed breakwater reef.
2. Quality control: monitor the installation of the breakwater reefs so that they are the right size, in the right location, and are secure.
3. Pass out snacks and water to volunteers and make sure volunteers are taking necessary breaks.
4. Take photos and video to document the installation process
