




# Work for the Youth Conservation Corps

If you are between the ages of 15 and 18, are interested in working on a National Wildlife Refuge and like to work in the out-of-doors, consider applying for a Youth Conservation Corps position. The crew will work with refuge biologists and maintenance workers on many projects including trail maintenance, painting, constructing and repairing facilities as well as fencing endangered piping plover nests and controlling invasive plant species.
