There are recent news articles about Lake Tecumseh and I want to ensure that the Lake is properly referenced as Brinson Inlet Lake. Do you have any information about the renaming of the Lake. April 10, 2012. Enjoyed your post. Elizabeth Brinson, daughter of Mathew Brinson, married Edward Brown in abt 1727. They lived in Piney Island, not sure where that was. Their son, John Brown, was one in a long line of John Browns. He bought, what we believe, was the Brown property east of Doziers Bridges. It is now the Seaboard Road area, developments of Southgate, Chelsea, Highgate Crossing, down to the 7-11 at the corner. Mr. Brinson left some land to his daughter when he died. She would be my great X6 grandmother!!

Take a look at the book "Here, There, & Yonder Cason & Sons A Brinson Genealogy" by Robert Brinson which includes house picture, maps, wills,etc. Book indicates house destroyed in 1943 by a tornado when a hurricane was in the area. Also includes a picture of the Brinson home in New Bern NC. Researching a Cason Scott family in the area. Cason Brinson sold some land to Cason Scott in 1750 on Goose Ck, tributary to the Neuse River, and located just down river from New Bern.

Need information on the Brinson Inlet and the Brinson House. from what I have been told the house was destroyed in 1940's during a storm ? hurricane perhaps???. I have also been told that Lake Tecumseh was renamed Brinson Inlet Lake by Va Beach City Council in 1986. I have been told Thomas Brinson lived in Princess Anne Co. having immigrated from England.his name is mentioned in a deed book April 15, 1674 pg 108 Deed Book E of Norfolk Co.
