# Festival of the Birds

- **Guided Bird Walks.** Every half hour, starting at 9:00 am until 3:00 pm. Come enjoy bird walks led by local naturalists along the wetlands trail. You will be amazed at the large variety of migratory birds that use Oaks Bottom during their migratory route.
- **Children's Activities.** Kids from ages 3 to 11 will love the hands-on activities, especially painting rocks and building a real birdhouse.
- **Butterfly Surprise.** Walk through the wetlands with a real-life biologist who will show you some animal-finding skills and where to find butterflies. Learn how, when, and butterflies.
- **Storytelling and Live Music.** Local musicians. Come hear about migratory birds in the Portland area.
- **Birds of Prey.** From Audubon Society of Portland's Wildlife Care Center, you can meet in person Finnegan the Peregrine Falcon, Julio the Great Horned Owl, Hazel the Northern Spotted Owl, Jack Sparrowhawk, the American Kestrel and Ruby, the Turkey Vulture.
- **Interactive Displays.** Visit with local partners of the Migratory Bird Treaty Program and find out what is happening locally to protect and enhance our bird populations.
