


Northern Rocky Mountain Wolf Distinct Population Segment (DPS) Boundary In Oregon



The DPS includes a portion of Eastern Oregon, east of the centerline of Highway 395 and Highway 78 north of Burns Junction and that portion of Oregon east of the centerline of Highway 95 south of Burns Junction. It's the area colored tan on this map. Any wolves found west of this line in Oregon are still federally listed as endangered, and have full protection under the federal Endangered Species Act and Oregon law. Any wolf east of the line is protected by Oregon law.
