Example from Hylebos Creek

The Jordan Restoration Project provided habitat restoration along Hylebos Creek in the Puyllaup River floodplain on a five acre private parcel with log waste fill. The waterway was reshaped to create a freshwater tidal marsh with three feet of daily tidal flux.

Restoration planting engaged the community through volunteer planting events. Careful planting and soil reconstruction led to rapid revegetation.

This site provided an opportunity to reconstruct historic marsh communities with minimal invasive issues.
