What Are Nature Clubs?

Inspired by the Backyards & Beyond curriculum developed by Arizona 4-H, US Fish and Wildlife Service, National Phenology Network, and Children & Nature Network, **Nature Clubs** are designed to “connect youth with the outdoors through creative, active, and meaningful experiences in nature.”

The intention of **Nature Clubs** participation is to connect youth with the outdoors by:

- Nurturing a child/nature relationship
- Inspiring a sense of wonder
- Enjoying the freedom to play
- Instilling a sense of place
- Engaging in environmental action

Nature Club Leaders serve as mentors who guide children in explorations of the nature in their own neighborhoods. Together they explore the nature around them, and initiate environmental projects that conserve natural resources in their communities. Through Nature Clubs, children hone the leadership skills to become environmental stewards of the future.
