

## Entiat River Snorkel Survey, July 22, 2004

### Walkers

1. Mark entry point with red flagging.
2. Record starting temp./time in data book
3. Record number of observed spring Chinook and bull trout in data book, mark location on map.
4. Carcass recovery: check for missing adipose fin, remove snout if missing and place in head bag with #ID disk, fork length (cm), sex (M/F), remove 5 scales place on gum card, genetic sample use 3 punches from caudal fin, and cut tail off after sampling is complete.
5. Obtain visibility condition from snorkelers.
6. Record end temp/time

### Snorkelers

1. Snorkel in a down stream direction, when encountering large pools, get out above pool, walk to bottom of pool, and snorkel upstream through pool.  
Compare notes and record info.
2. Identify any jacks observed.
3. Identify Ad present or absent if possible.
4. Recover all carcasses for bio-sampling.
5. Record any observed bull trout.
