CHECK SHEET

REQUIRED

- Complete, **signed** FORM 3-200-7, Section A OR B, C and D
- A CHECK OR MONEY ORDER payable to the US Fish and Wildlife Service for \$100
Exemptions: government entities, including public/state universities
- Answers to QUESTION 1A – 1G
- Question 2a: a complete COLLECTION ACTIVITY TABLE
- Question 2b: a proposal with JUSTIFICATION AND METHODOLOGY
You may submit an existing grant proposal or other document as long as it is current
- Question 3a: a summary of YOUR BACKGROUND to conduct proposed activities
A curriculum vitae, while helpful, does not answer this question

IF APPLICABLE

- RESEARCH WHICH WILL OR MAY RESULT IN LETHAL TAKE - Question 3b: if you are lethally taking birds please provide justification as to why your sample will not have population-level effects as well as where you intend to donate specimens.
- APPLICANTS WHO LIVE OUTSIDE OF THE US - Question 3c: if you do not live in the U.S. (i.e. attend a U.S. University), please provide contact information for while you are in the U.S.
- IMPORT/EXPORT - Question 3d: Please provide:
 - The type of specimen, species, amount
 - The name of who will ship and who will receive specimens
 - The port of entry/exit to be used
- EAGLE APPLICATIONS – Please specify what measures you will take to ensure that specimens will remain usable by the National Eagle Repository, length of time specimens will be held prior to donation to the National Eagle Repository, and any parts you wish to retain.
