## Definitions

**Centennial** – a 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary; marking the completion of a period of 100 years.

**Conservation** – the act of conserving; careful utilization of natural resources in order to prevent depletion.

**Duck** – the Wood Duck (*Aix sponsa*) nests in trees. The male has a long crest and black, chestnut, green, purple, and white feathers.

**Egret** – the Reddish Egret (*Egretta rufescens*) is a resident of the Florida Keys. Their feathers can be buff, brown, or red (dark morph) or white (white morph).

**Falcon** – the Peregrine Falcon (*Falco peregrinus*) is one of the fastest birds. It is much used in falconry all over the world.

**Migratory** – to pass periodically from one region or climate to another within a period of time, such as a year or day.

**Redknot** – the Red Knot (*Calidris canutus*) is the largest sandpiper in North America and known for their extraordinarily long-distance migrations.

**Tanager** – Tanagers are New World songbirds, males of which are usually brightly colored. The Western Tanager (*Piranga ludoviciana*) ranges farther north than any other tanager.

**Tern** – the White Tern (*Gygis alba*) nests in Hawaii, with a small population in urban Honolulu. A single egg is laid, delicately balanced on a tree branch, building, or rock.

**Treaty** – a formal agreement between two or more countries; an international agreement.
