Common Name: Slevin's skink

Scientific Name: *Emoia slevini*

Description: Slevin's skink is a small lizard in the reptile family Scincidae. These skinks are about 3 in (77mm) long, not including the tail. They are darkly colored, from olive to brown, with darker flecks in a checkerboard pattern, and light orange to bright yellow underside. Slevin's skink is insectivorous, found on the ground or in trees.

Status: Known from Guam, Cocos Island, Rota, Tinian, Guguan, Alamagan, Asuncion, and Maug; now only known from Cocos Island, Sarigan, Guguan, Alamagan, Pagan, and Asuncion.

Threats: Rats, typhoons, brown tree snakes, monitor lizards
