

1) Follow this link, <http://gis.co.walton.fl.us/PublicPlanning/>, to the Walton County Website interactive GIS mapping platform for planning.

2) Click on the button 'Search for Location' in the upper left hand corner, select 'Search by Address' or 'Search by Parcel ID' and enter the requested information. If using a parcel ID, make sure it is entered exactly as printed on official documents; all '-' must be present and there must be no extra spaces at the front or back.

3) If the search returns a result, right-click on the non-bold parcel number and select 'Zoom To.' If the search does not return a result, check your entry and try again, or try using a different kind of search.

4) Once the specified parcel is highlighted, look in the 'Map Contents' box on the left hand side of the screen and check the box next to 'Beach Mouse (Revised).' That will display the map of beach mouse habitat. If the specified parcel overlaps the beach mouse habitat map AT ALL, please fill out [this checklist](#) and email it to us. Also incorporate [these conservation measures](#) into your project. We will get to your request as soon as we can. **If the parcel does not overlap the beach mouse habitat map, no further coordination with USFWS for beach mice issues is needed.**
