Chapter 7: Sport Fish Restoration Reverted Funds

Reason for Rescinding the Chapter: The main purpose of 520 FW 7 is to tell States: A. Reverted funds in the Sport Fish Restoration Program must be used for research on fish of material value for sport or recreation; B. How they can apply for these funds; and C. What criteria we will use to select the proposals for funding. In 2005, Public Law 109-59 amended the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration Act to eliminate the requirement that reverted funds be used for research. Reverted funds now supplement the funds available for the annual apportionment. We will address the requirements of the 2005 amendment in our revised chapter on Sport Fish Restoration: Funding, Eligibility, and Fees.
