

**Federal Aid Grant Agreement**  
Formerly the Project Agreement

**The Grant Agreement Package is normally for a period of one year and includes:**


- A Grant Agreement, Form 3-1552;
- A schedule of funded projects, if more than one project is to be funded;
- A breakdown of estimated costs by program and subprogram, if appropriate; and
- Supporting documents, as needed.

**The Grant Agreement is used to:**

- Document the terms and conditions of the grant;
- Obligate the Federal share of the estimated project costs, by program; and
- As needed, provide information to monitor uses of funds by supprogram or purposes; e.g., boating access, aquatic education, hunter education, marine/freshwater fisheries projects.
