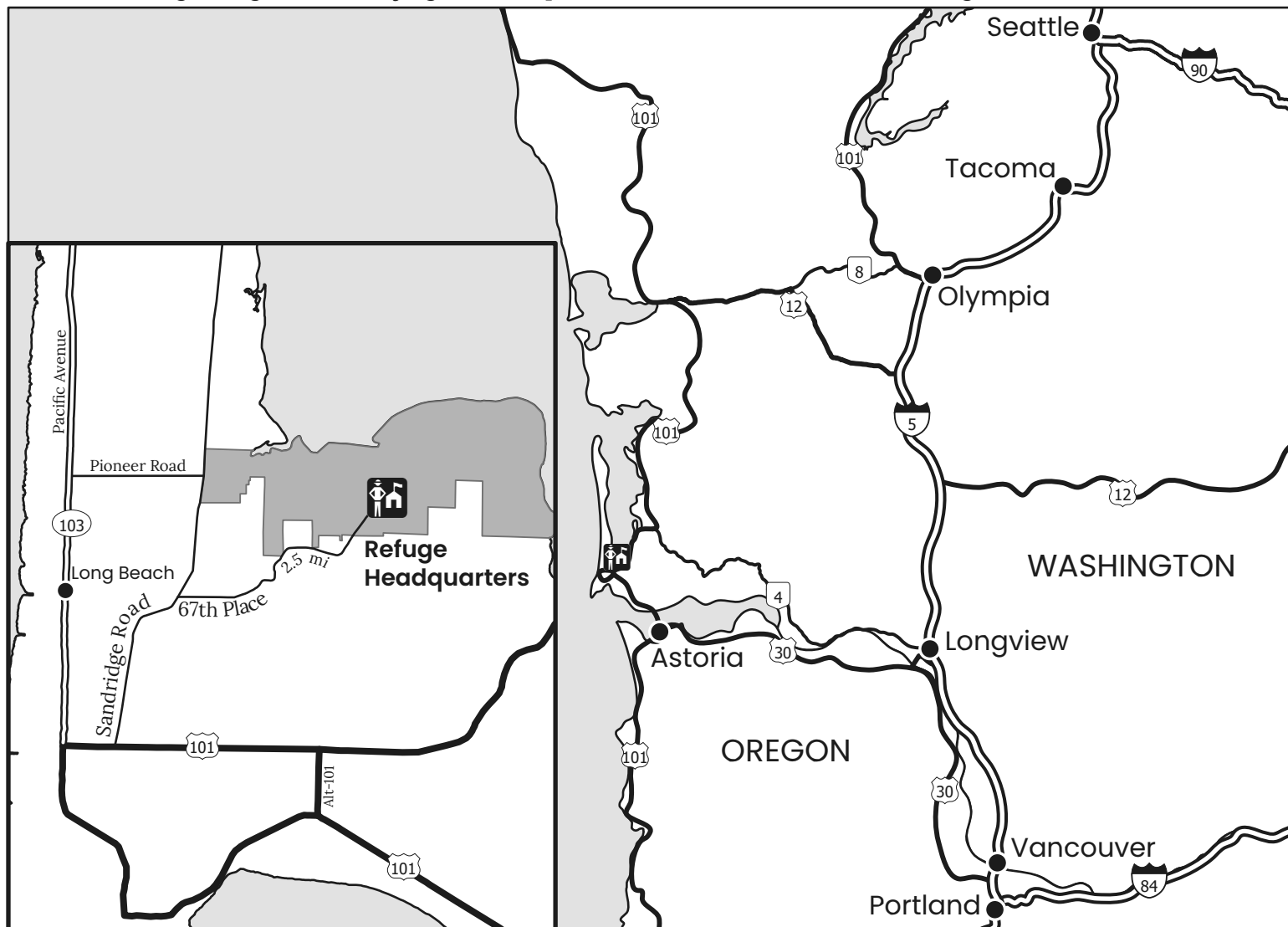

Navigating to the Refuge Headquarters - 7112 67th Place, Long Beach, WA 98631



The Willapa National Wildlife Refuge Headquarters is located in the coastal town of Long Beach in SW Washington. Be advised that navigation services are not necessarily reliable. We suggest confirming it is taking you to the correct address before proceeding. **Access to the headquarters building is only available by way of Sandridge Road to 67th Place.**

If traveling from...

Portland/Vancouver Metro Area: Take Interstate 5 North to Highway 30 West, following signs to the Long Beach Peninsula. In Astoria, OR, take Highway 101 North across the Astoria-Megler Bridge into Washington. Turn left, continuing on Hwy-101 North. Turn right onto Alt-101, then left onto Hwy-101. Turn right onto Sandridge Road. After 1.5 miles, turn right onto 67th Place. The Refuge is at the end of the road, approximately 2.5 miles.

West Portland Area: Take either Highway 26 West or Highway 30 West to Highway 101 North. Cross the Astoria-Megler Bridge into Washington. Turn left, continuing on Hwy-101 North. Turn right onto Alt-101, then left onto Hwy-101. Turn right onto Sandridge Road. After 1.5 miles, turn right onto 67th Place. The Refuge is at the end of the road, approximately 2.5 miles.

Seattle/Tacoma Metro Area: Take Interstate 5 South to State Highway 8 West towards Highway 101. Take Hwy-101 South, continuing to follow signs for the Long Beach Peninsula. Turn right onto Sandridge Road. After 1.5 miles, turn right onto 67th Place. The Refuge is at the end of the road, approximately 2.5 miles.

Naselle: Take State Highway 4 West to Highway 101 South, continuing to follow signs for the Long Beach Peninsula. Turn right onto Sandridge Road. After 1.5 miles, turn right onto 67th Place. The Refuge is at the end of the road, approximately 2.5 miles.
