Parents: Your child visited the Sacramento National Wildlife Refuge recently. We hope you come and visit! The Refuge has trails, a visitor center, and a 6-mile driving tour. Earn a Junior Ranger badge, go birding, borrow binoculars, and learn about the outdoors!

The best time to visit is Oct – March. The Refuge is open daily 1 hour before sunrise to 1 hour after sunset. The visitor center is open 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. Monday – Friday (March – Oct) and open 7 days a week November – February. It is \$6 per vehicle per day or \$12 for a 1 year pass. If you have a Federal Duck Stamp or Interagency Pass it is free.
